He was called back in the Navy to serve again from 1950 through 1952. Afterwards he returned to Mountain Bell and completed 31 years of service before retiring because of his health.

His Masonic life began when he joined Temple Lodge #6 in 1953. He became Worshipful Master of that Lodge in 1968. He was initiated into Adah Chapter #5, March 16, 1962.

Mary Lou and Jim were married May 25, 1973 and between them had six children

They moved to Truth or Consequences in 1979. Jim joined Bethesda Lodge #64 then Mary Lou and Jim joined Hot Springs #58, May 20, 1980. Jim served as Worthy Patron in 1983 and 1992.

Jim served as Worthy Grand Patron with Betty Self during the Treasure the Yester-Year Grand Session in 1988-1989.
