IMPORTANT DATES:

- First Time Applicant Applications due to the local chapter by end of February
- Renewal Applicants due to chapter no later than March 19
- ALL applications from chapter level to Education Board must be received by April 1 to Chairman of Education Board

Section I

This section is for first time applicants.

First time applicants will need to complete this section and then send to local chapter representative for consideration. If the chapter recommends the application, they will complete their additional paperwork and submit to the state level.

Students applying for the first time should contact their local chapter for details. (Check the OES map (under "Join") on the website for local contact information, if you don't have it.)

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW APPLICANTS (*Next
section discusses returning applicants*)

The application must be turned into New Mexico Eastern Star through a New Mexico Chapter. If you do not know of a nearby Chapter, please contact the Education Board at education@oesnm.org and a member of the committee will give you the information for contacting a local Chapter. You may also use the on-site map to find a Chapter near you.

Read the entire application thoroughly and carefully. Make sure you meet the requirements for the scholarship, which include New Mexico legal residency and the number of recommendations and documents needed. You will send, to a local Chapter, THREE copies of your application, but only one official transcript is required. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. You do not need any Masonic or Eastern Star relationship to be eligible for this scholarship.

College/university attendance is not limited to four-year institutions. Included in eligible schools are two-year, or junior colleges, and trade schools. All schools must be accredited by a major accrediting institution. The school does not have to be in New Mexico. A total of four awards may be given to any recipient, and this included both undergraduate and graduate education. It does not have to begin with the freshman year.

The local Chapter will help you with the application and the Chapter scholarship committee will review the application for completeness. The application must be submitted to the local Chapter by their due date, typically end of February. It is your responsibility to contact the chapter to know of the exact date. The Chapter must review the application and send its recommendation to the State Committee by a set date. No late applications will be considered.

Some Chapters have a local scholarship, in addition to the one at the state level. Some Chapters use this application to determine awards of their scholarship, and others have their own application. When you are in contact with a local Chapter, ask if they have a local scholarship.

Eastern Star of New Mexico always looks forward to scholarship applications. The award is made on both academic and need qualifications, and the amount varies from year to year, depending on the amount of money in the scholarship account and the number of applications deemed worthy of award.

4. Must have completed 12 credit hours with passing grades last or each semester, (9 credit hours for Graduate students).
5. Cumulative grade of 2.5 or above, (3.0 for Graduate students).
6. Short Essay on last year or semester and what you are expecting to accomplish in this next year. The essay needs to be typed in 12 point font or larger.
